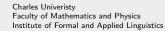
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Overview of the studies

- head: prof. Giovanni Adorni (originally computer scientist)
- Master's
 - Digital Humanities Comunicazione e Nuovi Media
 - ~25 students yearly
- PhD
 - Digital Humanities Digital Technology, Arts, Language, Culture and Communication
 - since 2005
 - ~8 students yearly
- strong multidisciplinarity, collaboration of multiple institutions
 - organization, courses, supervisors, exams...
 - computer science, linguistics, philology, modern cultures, communication
 - Genova, Savona (1h), Pisa (1.5h), Torino (2h)

Master's studies

- ~40 courses (ÚFAL: ~50 courses)
- default: in Italian only (by law) some fights over that
- origin of students:
 - ~40% science of communication (sociology)
 - ~20% literature
 - ~20% architecture
 - ~20% computer science
- explicit pursuit of "cross-contamination" of the students

PhD studies I.

- entrance exam
 - CV, list of publications, PhD project description
 - written test
 - oral exam
 - ~50% acceptance rate
- courses and seminars
 - no explicit PhD courses
 - seminars, DiHu Master's courses, other courses at Uni Genova
 - "external" courses and seminars, online courses, summer schools...
- obligations
 - an exam each year
 - teaching
 - internship (only some students)
 - work on research grants (don't care where money comes from)

PhD studies II.

- 3 years
 - can be extended upon request by max 6 months
 - think we crazy with 8-9 years
- sources of students:
 - ~30% from Uni Genova
 - ~30% from other Italian unis
 - ~30% from abroad
- money: EUR ~1,100
 - not great but sufficient for independent life
 - EUR ~500 avg rent (1-room flat)
 - EUR ~150 lunches
 - ...
 - MFF UK
 - CZK 10,500 base money
 - CZK 10,000 **cheap** rent in Prague

Interest of Dibris in future cooperation

- student exchanges
 - 1. PhD students
 - 2. Master's students?
- research (grant applications)
- our DiHu summer school?

Lessons learned

- give **enough money** to PhD students e.g. CZK 20,000?
 - this shouldn't be a secret we need to lure the students!
 - advertize publicly to prospective students (website, etc.)
- **forbid** PhD studies longer than 4-5 years
- cooperate with others more
 - Praha (FF UK, FSV UK, FIT ČVUT, FEL ČVUT...)
 - Plzeň (KIV ZČU)
 - Liberec (ITE TUL)
 - Brno (FF MU, FI MU)
- look for other than computer science students
 - philology, communication...
