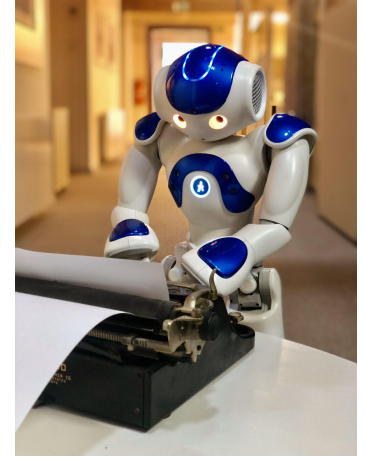

AI: When a Robot Writes a Play

- 10% of script written by a human
- 90% generated by GPT-2 language model
- human in the loop
- dramaturge, director, actors...

 - bathroom
 - cinema
 - horse

GPT-2 Language Model

- Task: Which word should follow?
 - I woke up in the morning and went to the... kitchen/bathroom/cinema/horse
- Learning from texts
 - How often words A B C are followed by word D (in the articles on Wikipedia)
 - “went to the bathroom” > “went to the horse”?

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 - Generate texts word by word

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- GPT Neural Language Models
 - Generate texts word by word
 - Learn from large amount of texts
 - news, books, websites, film subtitles...
 - billions of words
 - Advanced artificial neural networks
 - deep learning
 - word similarity
 - cinema ~ theatre
 - cinema ~ horse
